During the month of April, EKHS juniors will take part in the Michigan Merit Exam (MME), a series of tests required by the state of Michigan.

The MME consists of three parts:

- The SAT Plus Writing exam a nationally accepted college entrance exam (This exam normally costs test takers \$57.0 your student will be able to take it for free.)
- The ACT Work Keys exam a comprehensive system for measuring important workplace skills.
- The Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP) Science and Social Studies.

EKHS sophomores will be taking the **PSAT10**, which is designed to help prepare them for the SAT in their junior year of high school.

In order to accommodate this testing there will be an alternate schedule for EKHS students the week of April 10, 2017.

- Monday, April 10th regular full day for all students
- Tuesday, April 11th Regular Schedule for Sophomores (full day)
 - o Seniors do not report. All seniors are required to participate in Community Based Learning Projects. (Specific details have been shared in a separate senior communication)
 - Juniors will take the SAT (anticipated completion 1:30 pm)
- Wednesday, April 12th Half Day for all students
 - o 7:35-10:45 am
 - Juniors will take the ACT Workkeys
 - **Sophomores** will take the PSAT10
 - o Seniors will attend informational assemblies regarding year end senior activities and other presentations
- Thursday, April 13th regular full day
- Friday, April 14th regular full day
