Community-Based Learning Project

On the morning of Tuesday, April 11, 2017 all 11th graders will be participating in State required standardized testing. All 12th grade students are excused from school on this day. As a result of not attending school on April 12, seniors will need to complete 3.5 hours of one or more documented learning experiences to fulfill State of Michigan attendance requirements.

Seniors will be required to complete one or more documented learning experiences that will meet the needs of the individual student. During the next four months, it is a requirement for all seniors to be involved with some type of learning experience for a minimum of three and one-half (3.5) hours. We encourage each senior to find something he/she is interested in, excited about, and can learn from.

Learning experiences may include job shadowing, college visits, or community service projects in one's neighborhood or at organizations such as Habitat for Humanity, Goodwill, God's Kitchen, a local church, Kid's Food Basket, a local nursing home, the library, or a city recreation department. The goal is to have each senior be involved in some type of learning situation outside of the classroom.

The bottom portion must be returned to school by Wednesday, April 19, 2017 or students will be required to attend two (2) Saturday school sessions scheduled for April 22, 2017 and April 29, 2017
